6.1.B INTERVIEW GUIDE



Interview goal: What information do you want to gather and why?

- The goal of my interview is to explore how SSF people feel about their working conditions.
- The goal of my interview is to gather stories of women fighting against discrimination in fisheries.

Introductory questions: questions that identify your interviewee, you can determine what is important to your project. Below are some examples.

- Name & Age
 - When a subject is sensitive, some people feel uncomfortable sharing their real name. You can ask them to provide a fake name or what is known as a *pseudonym*.
- Job or Type of work
- Current location or community's location

Background questions: Before getting into specifics it is always important to find out a bit of their life journey. This can be 1 or 2 questions. Below are some examples.

- What is your favorite local meal?
- How did you come to be a part of this community?



6.1.B INTERVIEW GUIDE

Specific questions to the theme. This is specific to your goal, and you can determine your question in clear themes:

- Theme 1: Decent Work
 - What do you understand as decent work?
 - What working conditions would you like to change?
- Theme 2: Discrimination against Women in Fisheries
 - What are the challenges of working in fisheries as a woman?
 - How do you feel when you work with men and when you work with women?
